BACKGROUND: The Laredo Police Department personnel is at times requested by private businesses that have the need to employ off-duty officers for added security in the city. The RollKall platform will allow for the department to track and monitor hours worked by officers outside of their employment with the City of Laredo. RollKall will provide a hybrid solution that allows them to fully manage a selected set of vendors while allowing LPD to maintain control of vendors with the RollKall platform. RollKall will provide monthly/quarterly reports to command staff as desired for any personnel working secondary employments.

Whereas, Laredo Police Department agrees that the scope of services provided by RollKall is of benefit to the department for better control of sworn personnel off-duty employment; and

Whereas, RollKall mobile application utilized by sworn personnel allows them to clock in/out, track jobs, view job history, job reminders and alerts; and

Whereas, RollKall will schedule jobs requested by vendors (secondary employers) in accordance to department rules and regulations, and will invoice vendors; and

Whereas, the Chief of Police recommends the approval of this memorandum of understanding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: Authorizing the City Manager to enter into and execute a memorandum of understanding between the City of Laredo Police Department (LPD) and RollKall Technologies, LLC (RollKall) for the purpose of providing administrative and operational management service for off-duty employment for sworn personnel with no cost to the City of Laredo.
