## ORDINANCE No. 2025-O-XXX

PUBLIC HEARING AND INTRODUCTORY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROPRIATE **ACCEPT** AND REVENUES **AND** EXPENDITURES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000.00 FOR THE METHODIST HEALTHCARE MINISTRIES, JUNTOS FOR BETTER HEALTH GRANT, WITH NO MATCH FOR THE CITY OF LAREDO PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT FOR THE TERM PERIOD FROM JANUARY 01, 2025 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2025, WITH TWO (1) ONE YEAR RENEWALS THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2027, FOR A TOTAL GRANT AMOUNT OF \$750,000.00. FUNDS WILL BE ACCOUNTED FOR IN THE LAREDO PUBLIC **HEALTH DEPARTMENT FUND – JUNTOS FOR BETTER** HEALTH.

**WHEREAS**, the agreement between City of Laredo Public Health Department and Methodist Healthcare Ministries will enable the Juntos for Better Health to deliver education, outreach, and comprehensive healthcare services in our community. The program will include integrated behavioral health which combines both primary care and behavioral health.

## NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate revenues and expenditures in the amount of \$250,000.00 for the Methodist Healthcare Ministries, Juntos for Better Health – Community Mental Health Grant, with no match for the City of Laredo Public Health Department for the term period from January 01, 2025 through December 31, 2025, with two (1) one-year extensions through December 31, 2027 for a total grant amount of \$750,000.00. Funds will be accounted for in the Laredo Public Health Department Fund – Juntos for Better Health.

Section 2: The revenue account is 226-0000-323-4095 and the expenditure division is 226-6043 with Project Numbers HEMH04, HEMH05, and HEMH06.
