

RESOLUTION 2025-R-127

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$152,000.00 TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM. THE GRANT PERIOD WILL BEGIN OCTOBER 01, 2025 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2026; THIS GRANT IS FOR OVERTIME SALARIES. THE CITY OF LAREDO WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR A REQUIRED MATCH OF APPROXIMATELY \$36,000.00, FROM GENERAL FUND. FUNDING WILL BE AVAILABLE IN THE SPECIAL POLICE FUND.

Whereas, this is available to the City of Laredo, a grant entitled Selective Traffic Enforcement Program from the Texas Department of Transportation for Comprehensive enforcement which would pay for overtime salaries of off duty police officers for the performance period of October 1, 2025 – September 30, 2026; and

Whereas, the City Council finds that such acceptance should be made and will be beneficial to the City; and

Whereas, in order to ensure compliance and funding eligibility of said grant the Laredo Police Department is required to implement and fully comply with the requirements of our internal ethics and compliance program required by Title VI Texas Administrative Code Section 10.51 prior to award and/or disbursement of grant funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: Authorizing the City Manager to submit a grant application in the estimated amount of \$152,000.00 to the Texas Department of Transportation for the Comprehensive Selective Traffic Enforcement Program. The grant period will begin October 01, 2025 through September 30, 2026; this grant is for overtime salaries. The city will be responsible for a required match of approximately \$36,000.00, from General Fund.

Section 2: It authorizes the City Manager to execute all necessary documents to achieve said grant and to effectuate its terms.
