

**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-O-072**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS, REPEALING SECTION 24.92.4(5) OF THE CITY OF LAREDO LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE, WHICH REQUIRED THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF AT LEAST THREE-FOURTHS OF ALL MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO OVERRULE A RECOMMENDATION OF THE PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION THAT A PROPOSED CHANGE TO THE ZONING MAP AMENDMENT BE DENIED.**

**WHEREAS**, section 211.006(f) of the Texas Local Government Code provides that a municipality's governing body by ordinance may provide that the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of all its members is required to overrule a recommendation of the municipality's zoning commission that a proposed change to a regulation or boundary be denied; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Laredo, by ordinance, adopted section 211.006(f) of the Texas Local Government Code, which codified the language of 211.006(f) into the Laredo Land Development Code under section 24.92.4(5); and

**WHEREAS**, on April 2, 2024, the City Council, by majority vote, voted to remove the requirement that the affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of all its members is required to overrule a recommendation of the Planning & Zoning Commission that a proposed change to the zoning map amendment be denied.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS THAT:**

**Section 1.** Section 24.92.4(5) is hereby repealed.

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately after Final Reading and upon passage.
