

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-R-102

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS APPROVING A LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LAREDO – BRIDGE SYSTEM AND THE U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION (CBP) FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSTALLING/MOUNTING OF DRAWBRIDGE CAMERAS AT SPECIFIED LOCATION AT WORLD TRADE BRIDGE, THE CAMERAS ARE INTENDED TO MONITOR AND DETER ANY ILICIT FOOT TRAFFIC OF INDIVIDUALS ENTERING WITHOUT INSPECTION WHILE USING THE WORLD TRADE BRIDGE, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL RELEVANT DOCUMENTS, AND ANY OTHER MATTERS INCIDENT THERETO; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. THIS LICENSE IS BEING GRANTED WITHOUT MONETARY COST OR MONETARY COMPENSATION TO THE CITY OF LAREDO BRIDGE SYSTEM. U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION (CBP) ACKNOWLEDGES THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR ALL COSTS AND MAINTENANCE OF THE SITE FOR THE PERMITTED USE.

WHEREAS, The U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) seeks to license certain real property that is owned by the City of Laredo in Webb County, State of Texas;

WHEREAS, the City of Laredo is willing to license said property to CBP;

WHEREAS, the sole purpose of this license is to install/mount cameras at World Trade Bridge to monitor and deter any illicit foot traffic of individuals entering without inspection while using the World Trade Bridge;

WHEREAS, CBP agrees that the installation of these cameras will provide a significant benefit to the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) by enhancing their ability to monitor and deter illicit pedestrian traffic;

WHEREAS, CBP intends to implement these cameras, which will be maintained by the North Border Patrol Station Sensor Team; and

WHEREAS, CBP will conduct monthly site visits to service the equipment, including battery replacement and general maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1. That the City of Laredo Bridge System will allow the installation/mount of drawbridge cameras at World Trade Bridge,

Section 2. That the Bridge System will collaborate with the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) in order to monitor and deter illicit foot traffic of individuals,

Section 3. That the City of Laredo acknowledges that this License is being granted without cost or monetary compensation to the city, and

Section 4. That CBP shall have access to the sites for any maintenance that may be required for the cameras with prior notice to the Bridge System.
