## **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-R-114**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A FORMAL REQUEST TO THE LAREDO WEBB COUNTY AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (MPO)TO FUND A SAN BERNARDO AVENUE RENOVATION AND RESTORATION CORRIDOR STUDY FOR THE PURPOSE OF IDENTIFYING THE TRANSPORTATION AND PLACE MAKING IMPROVEMENTS NECESSARY FOR REVITALIZATION AS A DESTINATION CORRIDOR.

Whereas, the City Manager is authorized to submit a formal request to the Laredo Webb County Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) to fund a San Bernardo Avenue Renovation and Restoration Corridor Study on behalf of the City of Laredo; and

**Whereas,** the City is pursuing to identify the improvements necessary to maximize the economic potential of the corridor while creating a pedestrian friendly environment that serves the entire community; and

Whereas, the City intends to seek funding assistance to ensure the development of the study; and

**Whereas,** the study will assist in identifying and developing the proposed projects and tools that could be used to guide the economic growth and redevelopment of the corridor to promote economic and community development by taking advantage of the existent and underutilized potential of the area; and

**Whereas,** the study aims to address the needs for mobility, land use and growth patterns, commercial activity, economic development, and quality of life.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

**Section 1:** Authorizing the City Manager to submit a letter to the Laredo Webb County MPO requesting assistance to fund the San Bernardo Avenue Renovation and Restoration Corridor for the purpose of identifying the transportation and place making improvements necessary for the revitalization of San Bernardo Ave as a destination corridor.

Section 2: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
