A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND ENTER INTO A CONTINUATION CONTRACT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE HEALTH SERVICES, CHILDREN/YOUTH WITH SPECIAL HEALTH CARE NEEDS SYSTEMS DEVELOPMENT FAMILY SUPPORT AND COMMUNITY RESOURCES (FSCR) GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$125,000.00 WITH NO MATCH FOR THE CITY OF LAREDO PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT FOR THE TERM PERIOD FROM SEPTEMBER 01, 2026 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2027. FUNDS WILL BE ACCOUNTED FOR IN THE LAREDO PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT FUND – FSCR GRANT.

WHEREAS, The City of Laredo Public Health Department continues to provide a wide range of family support and health care community resource activities for children and young adults with special needs through funding from the Texas Department of State Health Services. Through the Children/Youth with Special Health Care Needs Systems Development Group Family Support and Community Resources (FSCR) Program, the City of Laredo Public Health Department serves families with children and youth with chronic health care conditions and growth and developmental issues that include respite services, community-based crisis prevention/intervention planning and implementation, assuring families access to care and support services, educational outreach trainings/workshops, parent to parent networking and support, and other activities that support children/youth with special health care needs and their families living in the community.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept and enter into a continuation contract from the Department of State Health Services, Children/Youth with Special Health Care Needs System Development Group Family Support and Community Resources (FSCR) Grant in the amount of \$125,000.00 with no match for the City of Laredo Public Health Department for the term period from September 01, 2026 through August 31, 2027. Funds will be accounted for in the Laredo Public Health Department Fund – FSCR Grant.

Section 2: The revenue account 226-0000-323-4092 and the expenditure division is 226-6040 with Project Number HEFR08.
