PUBLIC HEARING & INTRODUCTORY ORDINANCES

2. A Public Hearing and Introductory Ordinance of the City of Laredo, Texas, authorizing the City Manager to accept and appropriate revenues in the amount of \$48,742.00 and expenditures in the amount of \$48,742.00 for expansion of services for individuals case management services for individuals experiencing opioid use disorders, with a 0% match, for the Detoxification Department for the term period from November 1st, 2025 through September 30th, 2026. DETOXIFICATION CENTER: DR. SAN JUANA VIVIANA MARTINEZ, DIRECTOR

- 1. Authorizing the City Manager to amend contract FY24-100 for Beverage Services to Coca Cola Southwest Beverages LLC, Dallas, Tx. for the Detoxification Department. This amendment reflects a 41% contract increase, with annual cost of \$125,419.00 including a 5% increase in product cost for subsequent year. The term of this contract shall remain for a period of two years. This amendment applies to the second year of the contract year commencing on October 1, 2025, and ending on October 31, 2026. This contract may be extended for one (1) additional two (2) year periods, upon mutual agreement of the parties. Funding for this contract is available in the Detoxification budget.
- 2. Consideration to award contract FY25-081 to bidder Victoria's
 Catering, Laredo, Texas for annual amount not to exceed
 \$394,992.00 for providing meals for the detoxification department.
 The term of this contract is subject to future appropriations and will commence on October 1st, 2025; contract shall be for two-year period beginning the date of execution, with an option to renew for two additional years. Funding for this contract is available in the Detoxification Department budget.

Consideration to award a design/build contract to Nature Trails NC, LLC, Brevard, North Carolina for the Shiloh Bike Trails Improvements Project in response to RFQ FY25-ENG-19 for the amount not to exceed \$770,000.00, which includes design plans, specifications, and construction. Funding is available in the District Priority Funds.
- 4. Consideration for approval of the selection of the top ranked consultant for the RFQ FY25-ENG-57 Project Administration and Management Downtown Rail Corridor Safety Planning Project; and authorization to negotiate and award a professional services contract not to exceed \$5,000,000.00. A total of (5) firms responded to the request for qualifications Tuesday, September 18, 2025, and the top (2) firms presented on September 30, 2025 to the evaluation committee.
