AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF LAREDO CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 7, "BUILDINGS & BUILDING REGULATIONS," BY AMENDING ARTICLE 11. "REGISTRATION OF GENERAL CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS," SECTION 7-20 ADMINISTRATION; SECTION 7-28, INCREASE FOR ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE; A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; A PUBLICATION CLAUSE; AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHERAS the City of Laredo seeks to provide for safe and orderly construction activities within its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS the City of Laredo is authorized to regulate construction pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Chapters 51, 54 and 217; and

WHEREAS, the City of Laredo finds that the mandatory registrations of contractors and subcontractors is necessary for the public health, safety and general welfare.

Now THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1: Amending Chapter 7, Article II. Section 7-20 and Section 7-28 of the City of Laredo Code of Ordinances, to read as follows:

#### ARTICLE 11.

#### REGISTRATION OF GENERAL CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS

#### Section 7-20 Administration

The City Manager is the principal city official responsible for the regulation of the same and ordinances regulated; therefore, the City Manager will delegate any and all duties hereunder to the [Building Development Services Director] <u>Planning Department Director</u>. The [Building Development Services Director] <u>Planning Department Director</u> will instruct the Building Official or their designees to enforce said ordinance.

#### Section 7-28 Registration Fee

All general contractors and subcontractors except licensed electricians and plumbers shall be required to pay an annual administrative fee of [fifty] <u>sixty</u> dollars [(\$50.00)] <u>\$60.00</u> prior to undertaking work within the city limits which will be collected upon registration.

SECTION 2: SEVERABILITY. If for any reason any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, word or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect any other section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, word or provision of this ordinance, for it is the definite intent of

the City Council that every s	ection, paragraph	, subdivision,	clause, phr	rase, word	or provision
hereof be given full force and	d effect for its pur	pose.			

SECTION 3: PUBLICATION. This Ordinance shall be published in a manner by section 2.09 (D) of the charter of the City of Laredo

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its adoption and publication required by the City Charter and by state law.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 6, "ANIMALS AND FOWL," ARTICLE I "IN GENERAL" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES SECTION 6-119 "REGISTRATION, VACCINATION AND PERMIT FEES" TO UPDATE SECTION 6-119 "REGISTRATION, VACCINATION, AND PERMIT FEES" TO AMEND THE SCHEDULE OF FEES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS,** City of Laredo Public Health Department, Division of Animal Services is amending fees for services provided in order to address current operation needs; and,

WHEREAS, services are an essential part of public health and safety; and

## NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: Chapter 6, "Animal and Fowl." Article I "In General" of the City of Laredo Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended as follows:

#### ARTICLE I. – IN GENERAL

. . .

Chapter 6 – Fees for services.

This section does not and is not intended to exempt, change or modify the terms of any governing federal or state regulations which apply to the provision of animal care and service.

The City Manager "or designee" has the discretion to waive fees and costs during special circumstances, such as public health outbreaks, promotional events, and/(or) for high-risk populations and other affected groups.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances of the City of Laredo, Texas, except where the provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with the

provisions of such ordinances, in which event the conflicting provisions of such ordinances are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3.</u> It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

<u>Section 4.</u> The City Secretary of the City of Laredo is hereby directed to publish the proposed Ordinance as required by Section 2.09 of the Charter of the City of Laredo.

<u>Section 5.</u> That after its passage by City Council, this Ordinance shall be published one (1) time and become effective not less than sixty (60) days from the date of the public hearing on this Ordinance, in accordance with the City Charter.

#### PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION

On August 5, 2019, approved Ordinance 2019-O-102 to establish new building permit and plan/checking fees for residential construction.

#### **BACKGROUND**

H.B. 852 added Section 214.907 of the Local Government Code to provide that: in determining the amount of a building permit or inspection fee required in connection with the construction or improvement of a residential dwelling, a city may not consider: (a) the value of the dwelling; or (b) the cost of constructing or improving the dwelling; and (2) a city may not require the disclosure of information related to the value of or cost of constructing or improving a residential dwelling as a condition of obtaining a building permit except as required by the Federal Emergency Management Agency for participation in the National Flood Insurance Program. H.B. 852 was signed on May 21, and it is effective immediately.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS, AMENDING CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 7-2 ENTITLED "SAME-AMENDMENTS" AND CHAPTER 24, APPENDIX D, PERMIT FEES, TO INCREASE THE RESIDENTIAL BUILDING PERMIT FEE AND THE RESIDENTIAL PLAN REVIEW FEE; AND ESTABLISH NEW COMMERCIAL PLAN CHECKING FEES IN ACCORDANCE WITH HOUSE BILL (H.B.) 852; PROVIDING FOR A NEW WORKFLOW INSTANCE PLAN REVIEW FEE, PROVIDING FOR A RESUBMITTAL PLAN REVIEW FEE, PROVIDING FOR AN EXPEDITED PLAN REVIEW FEE, PROVIDING A CUMULATIVE AND REPEALER CLAUSE; **PROVIDING** Α SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING PUBLICATION; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Laredo is a Home Rule City acting under its Charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article X I, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, H.B. 852 provides that: (1) in determining the amount of a building or inspection fee required in connection with the construction or improvement of a residential dwelling, a city may not consider: (a) the value of the dwelling; or (b) the cost of constructing or improving the dwelling; and

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2019, staff presented the proposed fee schedule for residential building permits that is consistent with H.B. 852; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary and desirable to adopt the amendments to the Code of Ordinances and the Land Development Code as set forth in this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City of Laredo Code of Ordinances, Chapter 7, Section 7-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 7-2. — Same—Amendments.

The following sections of the International Building Code are modified to be specifically tailored to the City of Laredo:

Section 109.2 Schedule of Permit Fees. On buildings, structures, electrical, gas, mechanical and plumbing systems or alterations requiring a permit, a fee for each permit shall be paid as required, in accordance with the following schedule established herein:

## SCHEDULE OF PERMIT FEES COMMERCIAL - TOTAL VALUATION FEE

\$1,000.00 and less	No fee, unless inspection required, in which case a \$50.00 fee for each inspection shall be charged.

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE FEE**

For the moving of any building or structure, the fee shall be \$50.00. A \$50.00 administrative fee is for inspection of building site, setback, zoning regulations and the requirement of section G501 of the International Building Code will be charged.

#### **DEMOLITION FEE**

For the demolition of any building or structures, the fee shall be:

0 up to 100,000 cu ft: \$50.00 100,000 cu ft and over: \$0.50/ 1,000 cu ft

#### **PLAN-CHECKING FEES**

When a plan is required to be submitted by Section 105.1 of the International Building Code, a planchecking fee shall be paid to the Building Official at the time of submitting the plans and specifications for checking. Said plan-checking fee shall be paid as required, in accordance with the following fee schedule established herein:

<u>Section 4.</u> It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

<u>Section 5.</u> The City Secretary of the City of Laredo is hereby directed to publish the proposed Ordinance as required by Section 2.09 of the Charter of the City of Laredo.

<u>Section 6.</u> The publishers of the City Code of Laredo, Texas are authorized to amend said code to reflect the changes adopted herein and to correct typographical errors and to index, format and number paragraphs to conform to the existing code.

AMENDING THE CITY OF LAREDO CEMETERY FEE ORDINANCE, WHICH IS LOCATED IN THE CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 8; ARTICLE 23, ENTITLED "SAME - FEES CHARGED" BY ADDING TWO NEW SECTIONS, SPECIFICALLY SECTION (B)(5) AND SECTION (B)(6) PROVIDING AND ESTABLISHING THE COSTS AND FEES FOR NICHE SALES TO THE PUBLIC FOR STORAGE OF URNS.

, the City of Laredo Cemetery, in its continuing effort to provide the public with additional options to honor their loved ones with honor and dignity, is now selling niches contained within a columbarium for the storage of urns; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance provides the costs and fees associated with such services, including the purchase cost of the niche, the internment service of each urn within the niche (each niche holds a maximum of two niches) and the recording fee; and

#### NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>: Chapter 8; Article 23, of the City of Laredo Code of Ordinances, entitled "Same - Fees Charged", shall be amended by adding sections (b)(5) and (b)(6) which establish the costs and fees for the newly available services at the City of Laredo Cemetery, which will offer the sale of Niches located in columbariums for the storage of urns.

<u>Section 2:</u> This ordinance shall be published in a manner provided by Section 2.09 (D) of the Charter of City of Laredo.

<u>Section 3</u>: This ordinance shall become effective as and from the date of publication specified in Section 2 hereinabove.

Section 4: Severability

If any provision, section, subsection sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance, or the application of this ordinance the same to any person or set of circumstances is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void or invalid the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or their application to other persons or sets of circumstances shall not be affected thereby, it being the intent of the City Council in adopting this ordinance that no portion hereof or provision herein or regulation contained herein shall become inoperative or fail by reason of any unconstitutionality, voidness or invalidity of another portion hereof, and all provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable for that purpose.
