RESOLUTION NO. 2024-R-133

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,049.00 FROM THE STATE COMPTROLLER'S LAW ENFORCEMENT EDUCATION FUNDS PROGRAM FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING EXPENSES RELATED TO THE CONTINUING EDUCATION OF FULL-TIME OFFICERS AND LAW ENFORCEMENT SUPPORT AT THE LAREDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT NO LOCAL MATCH IS REQUIRED.

WHEREAS, the City Manager is authorized to accept this grant on behalf of the Laredo International Airport; and

WHEREAS, the Laredo International Airport will accept a grant in the amount of \$3,049.00 from State Comptroller's Law Enforcement Education Funds Program; and

WHEREAS, the Laredo International Airport use these funds for expenses related to the continuing education of full-time equivalent officers and law enforcement support at the Laredo international Airport; and; and

WHEREAS, the Laredo International Airport has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of funds, the Laredo International Airport assures that the funds will be returned to the State Comptroller's Law Enforcement Education Funds Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

SECTION 1. The City of Laredo herby accepts the award of a grant from the State Comptroller's Law Enforcement Education Funds Program, as a supplemental award, for the purpose of funding expenses related to the continuing education of full-time equivalent officers and law enforcement support at the Laredo international Airport; and; and

SECTION 2. This resolution shall be cumulative of all provisions of resolutions of the City of Laredo, except where provisions of this resolution are in direct conflict with the provisions of such resolutions, in which event the conflicting provisions of such resolutions are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this resolution are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this resolution, shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree or any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this resolution, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this resolution of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall become effective upon passage thereof.
