

RESOLUTION NO.

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,068,104.00 FROM THE COMMISSION ON STATE EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS TO FUND 9-1-1 PROGRAM AND EQUIPMENT BUDGETS FOR THE SOUTH TEXAS REGION, INCLUDING JIM HOGG, STARR, WEBB, AND ZAPATA COUNTIES, FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 2025 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2027.

WHEREAS, on September 16, 2024 City Council adopted the 9-1-1 Regional Administration fiscal year 2025-2026 annual budget (RCOM26); and

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2025, City Council adopted the 9-1-1 Regional Administration fiscal year 2026-2027 annual budget (RCOM27); and

WHEREAS, the City of Laredo will accept a grant from the Commission on State Emergency Communications (CSEC) to fund the 9-1-1 Program and Equipment budgets for the South Texas Region; and

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2025, the Commission on State Emergency Communications approved the FY 2026 and FY 2027 Strategic Plan for South Texas 9-1-1 Region, as administered by the City of Laredo; and

WHEREAS, the Strategic Plan authorizes expenses for all administrative, program, and capital budgets for South Texas Region, including Jim Hogg, Starr, Webb and Zapata Counties; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1:

The City of Laredo 9-1-1 Regional Administration will accept a grant from the Commission on State Emergency Communications to fund 9-1-1 program and equipment budgets in order to administer the 9-1-1 Service Program in the South Texas Region.
