A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS, FORMALIZING THE CONTINUED ESTABLISHMENT OF THE LAREDO YOUTH COUNCIL, RESCINDING THE PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED BYLAWS AND ADOPTING THE LAREDO YOUTH COUNCIL PROGRAM HANDBOOK.

WHEREAS, on February 3. 2020, the Laredo City Council moved to create the Laredo Youth Council; and

WHEREAS, In 2021, the Laredo City Council adopted bylaws to guide the LYC as a City Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Laredo City Council wants to encourage and educate the next generation of our City's leaders about the elements that go into city government: and

WHEREAS, through the administration of the program, it has been determined that the Laredo Youth Council functions more effectively as a youth development program rather than a formal City committee; and

WHEREAS, the Laredo City Council seeks to encourage and educate the next generation of leaders about municipal government, public service, and civic responsibility; and

WHEREAS, the Laredo City Council finds that the creation of the Laredo Youth Council is in the best interest of the City,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of Laredo, Teas formalizes the continued establishment of the Laredo Youth Council as a city-supported youth leadership and engagement program designed to educate and involve high school students in municipal government and public service.

Section 2. The City Council of Laredo, Texas rescinds the previously adopted LYC bylaws approved on October 18, 2021.

Section 3. The Laredo Youth Council Program Handbook is adopted which shall serve as the guiding document for administration, structure, and operation of the program.

Section 4. The LYC Handbook shall be maintained and administered by the City Manager's Office or designee who may make minor administrative or procedural updates as necessary to reflect operational needs, provided such changes remain consistent with the program's purpose or intent.

Section 5. This Resolution supersedes any prior resolutions, motions, or actions inconsistent with its provisions.
