Explanation of Award Amount

The payment amount for the QIA Part B award was calculated based on the review of the QIA Part B Special Fund application submitted by your agency. The award listed above was determined based on the review of your agency's application by members of Every Body Texas Programmatic and Financial Teams. The number listed above is an indication of what Every Body Texas is capable of funding to meet the goals articulated in your agency's Part B application.

Funding Guidelines

The award amounts listed above designate which of the areas the sub-recipient was funded to implement. The category areas in the funding application were as follows:

- **Creative partnership development:** Title X program encourages strategic partnership development to enhance program effectiveness. Partnerships should aim to increase and expand



access to family planning services. Partnerships may include increasing services to adolescents, SRH training, robust closed-loop referrals, pop-up clinics, strategy development for sustainability, etc.

- **Telemedicine delivery of SRH services:** Telehealth is an important tool to expand access to services across underserved areas in the state. Data shows that providers are unable to increase telehealth offerings without additional resources and investments in technology. This part B funding may be used to update or expand subrecipient investments in telehealth services to support access to SRH services in your area.
- **Sterilization services (including Vasectomies):** The provision of female and/or male sterilization services either offered directly at a Title X service site or through a contractual agreement with an external practice able to perform such services for clients served at the sub-recipient Title X service site. Sub-recipients who request this funding must have the federally required policies, procedures, and consent form in place.
