



Vending Proposal Response for City of Laredo

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1. Implementation & Maintenance

a) Monthly cost for use of the vending machine?

Fastenal will provide vending at no cost to the City of Laredo and will waive air card fees for any City of Laredo location that will use this option. The only cost associated with our vending program is the cost of the product purchased. We own the devices and do not charge customers for hardware use, service, support, or anything else.

b) What is the minimum cost for restocking the vending machine? Is there a minimum supply order?

There is no additional restocking fee or minimum supply order for our vending program.

c) What is the minimum and maximum term of the contract?

Initial Term: July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2023.

Renewal Options: Option to renew for two (2) additional one-year periods through June 30, 2025 EXTENDED THROUGH June 30, 2026. UC may renew the Agreement according to policy for two more years with a maximum contract term of 10 years. Suppliers will be notified in writing before extending the contract past June 30, 2026.

e) The proposal must reference a cooperative contract.

Fastenal intends to have City of Laredo utilize OMNIA Partners University of California, CA Systems Contract # 2018.000208 for Maintenance, Repair, Operations (MRO) Supplies and Related Services.

This is provided at no cost to the City of Laredo.

3. Size and Shape of PPE Items

a) Is there a difference in cost of the size and shape of the vending machine?


No. Fastenal will provide machines to accommodate the City of Laredo's PPE needs at no additional cost.

We offer a diverse lineup of devices with common features such as employee ID-based access (connecting products to individuals and cost centers), cloud-based software (a simple, secure way to manage settings and access reporting), and layers of support to provide a turnkey program – from design and implementation to ongoing replenishment and optimization.



COIL MACHINES (5K & 3K)

Our coil devices provide maximum control over fast-moving items. The user has access to one product at a time (one transaction = one item dispensed). This allows local managers to set product-specific access controls (so that certain items can only be vended by authorized job titles, or in limited amounts within a time period). A versatile solution for wide-ranging but generally smaller-sized items.



MULTIPURPOSE LOCKERS (2, 3, 12, 18, 27, 30 & 36 DOOR)

These devices provide three basic functions: (1) vend large consumable items, (2) automate the check-out/return process for assets (tools, scanners, tablets, etc.), and (3) serve as an automated will-call station for spot-buy deliveries from Fastenal.



SENSOR LOCKERS (18, 24 & 27 DOOR)

Sensor lockers provide per-item traceability along with 'grab and go' access. The user makes a selection to unlock a cabinet, and weight sensors automatically detect and report the number of items taken. This technology is for dispensing only, not for asset management. A good fit for high-volume consumables that require greater traceability than our multipurpose locker units.



SENSOR CABINETS & DRAWER UNITS

Also provide 'grab and go' access to a variety of products while connecting each item to the user. The single-door model is a large cabinet for various-sized MRO items, including cans and boxes. The drawer-only model is equipped with bins for loose consumables, including cutting tools. And the combo door-drawer unit functions as a dual metalworking/MRO solution.

4. Stock Control

a) Software available to track the issuance of safety supplies? Reports available?

Yes. Fastenal provides inventory and spend visualization through FAST 360°, an on-demand reporting dashboard accessible via Fastenal.com. This is truly a unique solution in the industry, made possible by our high-touch service and FMI Technology program. FAST360° includes three core modules:



MY BUSINESS

A 'digital blueprint' of how Fastenal-managed inventory is organized across multiple facilities. Account holders can click on a facility, a location within that facility, the individual vending and bin stock devices within the location, and planograms of specific devices (a view similar to standing in front of the device and seeing what's in each inventory position).



MY INVENTORY

This tool takes the above data and makes it searchable. Account holders can search to see if a needed item is on hand and exactly where it's located, down to the specific vending or bin position. Filters and tools make it easy to search for products by product category tree, item description, or SKU (including your own internal part numbers).



MY SPEND

A suite of tools to analyze Fastenal purchasing activity based on invoice data. Local account holders can filter data by time period, account number, facility, supply channel, product category, or even an individual SKU to dial in on very specific aspects of spend. This produces a high-level view of that spend along with the SKU-level activity behind it.

VENDING SOFTWARE

Our FASTVend solutions are powered by cloud software that enables account holders to monitor and manage the vending devices anytime, anywhere, 24/7. Managers can use the reporting tools to trace each dispensed item to an individual user, a location and time, and if desired, accounting metrics such as a GL code or job number. This information can be used to address over-use issues, simplify job costing, and gain a new level of insight into how products are being used throughout the facilities.

5. Ease of Vending PPE Items

a) Time needed to issue safety supplies?

All of our machines run on the same user-friendly software platform. From the keypad on each machine to the administrative features and reporting, we want our customers to be able to use our technology without hours of training.

Each vending transaction takes approximately 1 minute to complete. Additionally, Fastenal tests and certifies each product for vending to ensure reliability. Our 5K and 3K devices incorporate patented Verified Vend™ technology which checks and verifies the accuracy of each vend. If the machine is loaded correctly, you will enjoy trouble-free vending.

If congestion at the vending device becomes an issue for the City of Laredo, upon mutual agreement, we can invest in additional vending devices to ensure City of Laredo personnel get the safety supplies they need in a timely and efficient manner.

6. Vending Repairs & Contingency Plans

a) What is the minimum time to have a machine fixed?

Most basic fixes and/or adjustments can be completed by our local teams typically same or next-day. Larger repairs that may require replacement parts or reconfigurations can be completed by our regional service center personnel typically within 1 week.

If City of Laredo's vending device is unusable for a period of time, we can provide manual access to the needed product. Depending on the vending device, we can provide a key to a site supervisor, so the device can be unlocked and items can be taken. Our local fulfillment center will also house emergency stock and can deliver product if items cannot be accessed.

Additional Inventory Management Solutions

In addition to the vending solutions mentioned in the previous sections, Fastenal offers a wide array of inventory management solutions tailored to meet the needs of each site. Following the completion of a site assessment or Total Cost of Ownership Analysis to understand the needs of the site, we can offer the following programs to meet your inventory needs.

FASTBin Technology Overview

As part of our mission to ensure continuous supply to your facilities, we're excited to offer technology that enables our local service teams to monitor fast-moving bin stock inventory remotely and continuously. Depending on your local needs, we can provide the following solutions to make our bin stock service more efficient and proactive.



FASTBinSM – RFID

This solution combines radio frequency identification (RFID) technology with a classic multi-bin system. Each bin has a unique RFID label on the back. When the front bin runs empty, the user places it on the top shelf, where an RFID controller senses the label, triggers a change in inventory state in our system, and puts our local service into motion.



FASTBinSM – IR

This modular system brings 24/7 monitoring to the point of use. Infrared (IR) sensors within each bin detect the current level based on the number of infrared beams blocked by product. We electronically monitor the changes in inventory state and plan our service accordingly.



FASTBinSM – SCALE

A weight-based system that provides real-time visibility to quantities and inventory values. Load cells beneath each bin sense and report real-time QOH for each bin. When inventory falls below the targeted replenishment trigger, the system automatically sends an alert to the servicing Fastenal location.


