ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AMMEND THE FY 2026 CITY OF LAREDO DETOXIFICATION CENTER BUDGET BY INCREASING AND APPROPRIATING REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$48,742.00. THE TEXAS OPIOID ABATEMENT FUND COUNCIL WAS FORMED TO ENSURE THAT MONEY RECOVERED THROUGH THE STATEWIDE OPIOID SETTLEMENT AGREEMENTS IS ALLOCATED FAIRLY AND SPENT TO PUT AN END TO THE OPIOID CRISIS IN TEXAS. THESE FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE AND WILL BE ACCOUNTED **FOR** IN THE **DETOXIFICATION** DEPARTMENT FUND.

WHEREAS, the City of Laredo obtained funds from the Texas Opioid Abatement Fund Council to the Detoxification Department, ROOTS Recovery Center, to provide voluntary inpatient medically monitored withdraw substance use treatment; and

WHEREAS, in order to adequately address these growing concerns within our community, the City Council deems it necessary to address substance use with the primary purpose of administering local and state laws pertaining to substance use treatments; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration of this matter, the City Council deems it advisable, and in the best interest of the general welfare of the City and its citizens, to amend the budget of the City of Laredo.
