

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-R-178

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO RATIFY THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,102,868 FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION FOR THE DESIGN OF THE EXTENSION OF RUNWAY 18R EXTENSION AND THE DEMOLITION OF THE ENGINEERING MATERIAL ARRESTING SYSTEM (EMAS) PROJECT. THE PERFORMANCE PERIOD WILL BE FROM JULY 2026 THROUGH JULY 2030. THE CITY OF LAREDO WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING A LOCAL MATCH OF \$110,677 FROM THE AIRPORT OPERATING FUNDS, FOR A TOTAL PROJECT COST OF \$2,213,456. FUNDING IS AVAILABLE IN THE AIRPORT OPERATING BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Laredo finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Laredo, that the Federal Aviation Administration Grant No. LRD-SWG-3-48-0136-108-2026 operated for the Fiscal year 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Laredo agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Federal Aviation Administration funds, the City Council of the City of Laredo assures that the funds will be returned to Federal Aviation Administration in full; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Laredo designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Laredo designates the City of Laredo Finance Director as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

SECTION 1. The City of Laredo hereby accepts the award of Grant No. LRD-SWG-3-48-0136-108-2026 from the Federal Aviation Administration, for the purpose of funding a design for the extension of Runway 18R and the removal of the Engineering Material Arresting System at the Laredo International Airport.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall be cumulative of all provisions of resolutions of the City of Laredo, except where provisions of this resolution are in direct conflict with the provisions of such resolutions, in which event the conflicting provisions of such resolutions are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this resolution are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this resolution, shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree or any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this resolution, since

the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this resolution of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall become effective upon passage thereof.
