

**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-R-91**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF LAREDO AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT GRANT NO. 3335709 FROM THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR'S HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE PURPOSES OF FUNDING THE AIRPORT'S FY25 OPERATION STONGARDEN GRANT. FUNDING FROM THIS GRANT WILL BE USED FOR OVERTIME AND FRINGE BENEFIT EXPENSES USED FOR STONEGARDEN OPERATIONS CONDUCTED BY AIRPORT LAW ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE CUMULATIVE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Laredo finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Laredo, that the Operation Stone Garden Grant be operated for the Fiscal year 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Laredo agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City Council of the City of Laredo assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Laredo designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Laredo designates the City of Laredo Finance Director as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The City of Laredo hereby accepts the award of Grant No. 3335709 from the Office of The Governor's Homeland Security Grant Program, as a supplemental award, for the purpose of funding the FY 2023 Operation Stone Garden Grant (OPSG).

**SECTION 2.** This resolution shall be cumulative of all provisions of resolutions of the City of Laredo, except where provisions of this resolution are in direct conflict with the provisions of such resolutions, in which event the conflicting provisions of such resolutions are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3.** It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this resolution are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this resolution, shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree or any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this resolution, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this resolution of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

**SECTION 4.** This resolution shall become effective upon passage thereof.
