

RESOLUTION 2026-R-35

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$60,000.00 TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE, CRIMINAL JUST DIVISION FOR THE FUNDING OF FY2027 CRIMINAL JUSTICE GRANT PROGRAM - LAREDO POLICE DEPARTMENT (LPD) MENTAL HEALTH/CRISIS INTERVENTION UNIT. THE GRANT PERFORMANCE PERIOD IS OCTOBER 01, 2026 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2027. THIS FUNDING WILL BE UTILIZED FOR OVERTIME AND TRAINING FOR THE LPD MENTAL HEALTH/CRISIS INTERVENTION UNIT. NO LOCAL MATCH IS REQUIRED. GRANT WILL BE AVAILABLE IN THE SPECIAL POLICE FUND.

Whereas, the City of Laredo finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Laredo, that the Criminal Justice Grant Program, LPD Mental Health/Crisis Intervention Unit, be operated for the 2026-2027 fiscal year; and

Whereas, the grant will provide funds for training and overtime for the Mental Health/Crisis Intervention Unit; and

Whereas, the City of Laredo has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City of Laredo assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

Whereas, the City of Laredo designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate this grant on behalf of the City of Laredo; and

Whereas, the City of Laredo designates the Financial Services Administrator as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: Authorizing the City Manager to submit a grant application in the estimated amount of \$60,000.00 to the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division for the funding of FY2027 Criminal Justice Grant Program - Laredo Police Department (LPD) Mental Health/Crisis Intervention Unit. The grant performance period is October 01, 2026 through September 30, 2027. This funding will be utilized for overtime and training for the LPD Mental Health/Crisis Intervention Unit. No local match is required. Grant will be accounted for in the Special Police Fund.

Section 2: It authorizes the City Manager to execute all necessary forms and documents to obtain said grant and to effectuate its terms.
