

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-O-_____

PUBLIC HEARING AND INTRODUCTORY ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF LAREDO MUNICIPAL HOUSING FUND FY2025-2026 ANNUAL BUDGET BY INCREASING REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000.00, RELATED TO THE AEP TEXAS TARGETED LOW INCOME PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY FRONTIER ENERGY, INC. THE PROGRAM WILL PROVIDE THE REPLACEMENT OF CENTRAL AIR CONDITIONING AND HEATING SYSTEMS IN MUNICIPAL HOUSING SINGLE-FAMILY HOMES TO IMPROVE ENERGY EFFICIENCY, HOUSING QUALITY AND, IMPROVE RESIDENT QUALITY OF LIFE.

WHEREAS, the City Council previously approved Resolution No. 2026-R-62 on March 16, 2026, authorizing the City Manager to submit and accept a grant application to AEP Texas for the AEP Texas Targeted Low Income Program administered by Frontier Energy, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the AEP Texas Targeted Low Income Program provides funding for energy efficiency improvements, including the replacement of central air conditioning and heating units for eligible single-family dwellings; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the FY 2025–2026 Annual Budget of the Municipal Housing Fund to reflect the additional grant revenues and corresponding expenditures in the amount of \$50,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that such budget amendment serves a public purpose by improving housing conditions and energy efficiency for low-income residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: The FY 2025–2026 Annual Budget of the Municipal Housing Fund is hereby amended by increasing revenues and expenditures in the amount of \$50,000.00 from AEP Texas through Frontier Energy, Inc.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage thereof.
