

RESOLUTION 2024-R-242

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$12,497.50 FROM THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, HOMELAND SECURITY GRANTS DIVISION (HSGD) FOR THE 2021 OPERATION STONEGARDEN GRANT (OPSG) TO PURCHASE A COMMUNICATION RADIO CONSOLETTTE. NO LOCAL MATCH IS REQUIRED. FUNDING IS AVAILABLE IN THE SPECIAL POLICE FUND.

Whereas, the City of Laredo designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate this grant on behalf of the applicant agency; and

Whereas, the City of Laredo will accept additional funds in the amount of \$12,497.50 from the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grants Division to fund the 2021 Operation Stonegarden Grant; and

Whereas, the City of Laredo finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Laredo that the 2021 Operation Stonegarden be operated; and

Whereas, the City of Laredo has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City of Laredo assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: A resolution of the City Council of the City of Laredo, Texas, authorizing the City Manager to accept a supplemental grant in the amount of \$12,497.50 from the Office of The Governor, Homeland Security Grants Division (HSGD) for the 2021 Operation Stonegarden Grant (OPSG) to purchase a communication radio consolette. No local match is required. Funding is available in the Special Police Fund.

Section 2: It authorizes the City Manager to execute all necessary forms and documents to obtain said grant and to effectuate its terms.
