

**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-R-111**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000.00 TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, THE FY 2026 SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL (SS4A) GRANT PROGRAM TO FUND ACQUISITION OF VEHICLE MONITORING DEVICES WITH TELEMATIC CAPABILITY FOR A BEHAVIOR PROGRAM TO REDUCE EMS RESPONSE UNIT CRASHES AND IMPROVE PATIENT OUTCOMES. THE SS4A GRANT HAS A TWENTY PERCENT MATCH REQUIREMENT AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION. THIS NOTICE OF FUNDING OPPORTUNITY IS ON A REIMBURSEMENT BASIS. FUNDING IS AVAILABLE IN THE SPECIAL FIRE GRANTS FUND.**

**Whereas**, the U.S. DEPT.OF TRANSPORTATION has announced, and made available reimbursable funds for the *SAFE STREETS AND ROADS FOR ALL* Grant Program for the 2026 fiscal year that will allow for the acquisition of new vehicle monitoring equipment; and

**Whereas**, the *City Council of the City of Laredo* acknowledges and expresses its sincere and cordial intention to apply for the aforementioned funding opportunity, whose implementation date cannot begin until funding is approved, and that the project must be completed in 24 months upon signed funding agreement between the Department of Transportation and the recipient.

**Whereas**, the *City Council of the City of Laredo* finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Laredo, Texas to formally apply and submit an application for the aforementioned Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant Program through the City of Laredo's Fire Department in order to improve the department's performance, efficiency and safety during incident response; and

**Whereas**, the *City Council of the City of Laredo* agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant , the City of Laredo assures that the funds will be returned to the U.S. Department of Transportation in full; and

**Whereas**, the *City Council of the City of Laredo* designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:**

Section 1: Authorizing the City Manager to submit a grant application in the amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 to The U.S. Department of Transportation, under the Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant Program, to acquire vehicle monitoring devices with telematic capability. The SS4A grant has a twenty percent match requirement at the time of application. This notice of funding opportunity is on a reimbursement basis. Funding is available in the Special Fire Grants Fund. Acct. 260-2499-524-9900.

**Section 2:** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
