A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION CONTRACT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE HEALTH SERVICES (DSHS) TO PERFORM MOBILE FOOD VENDOR (MFV) INSPECTION SERVICES AND RELATED PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE REGULATIONS, FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$68,720.00 FOR THE TERM PERIOD FROM JULY 01, 2026 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2027, WITH THE OPTION TO EXTEND FOR UP TO FOUR (4) ADDITIONAL YEARS. FUNDS WILL BE ACCOUNTED FOR IN THE LAREDO PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT FUND.

WHEREAS, The City of Laredo Public Health Department is entering into an Interlocal Cooperation Contract with the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) to provide Mobile Food Vendor (MFV) inspection services in accordance with state laws and regulations. Through this agreement, Laredo Public Health will conduct routine, pre-licensing, complaint-based, and compliance inspections of mobile food vendors within its jurisdiction as assigned by DSHS. Inspections will be performed using state-established protocols, including standardized reporting, documentation, and submission requirements, ensuring consistency with statewide food safety enforcement practices.

WHEREAS, through this agreement Laredo Public Health will be supporting the implementation of the statewide regulatory framework for mobile food vendors under the Texas Health and Safety Code and aligns the City’s inspection activities with DSHS oversight, ensuring continued protection of public health and food safety within the community.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept and enter into an Interlocal Cooperation Contract from the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) to perform Mobile Food Vendor (MFV) inspection services and related public health services in accordance with state regulations, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$68,720.00, for the term period from July 1, 2026 through August 31, 2027, with the option to extend for up to four (4) additional years. Funds will be accounted for in the Laredo Public Health Department Fund.

Section 2: The revenue account 226-0000-373-2081 with project HEMI01.
