## **RESOLUTION NO. 2025-RT-50**

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE THE LAREDO TRANSIT MANAGEMENT INC. (LTMI) PURCHASING AND PROCUREMENT POLICY REVISION NO. 5 DATED NOVEMBER 7, 2025. THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (FTA) REQUIRES THAT ALL TRANSIT SYSTEMS RECEIVING FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE MUST UPDATE THEIR POLICIES TO REFLECT THE MOST UPDATED FEDERAL RULING. NO FINANCIAL IMPACT.

This policy provides the policies and procedures related to the procurement of goods and services with funding from the FTA, other federal appropriations, the State of Texas and/or local sources. These guidelines ensure that LTMI obtains goods, and services in accord with federal, state and local requirements; and
