A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AMENDMENT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE HEALTH SERVICES (DSHS) FOR THE OBESITY PREVENTION GRANT PROGRAM FOR A DECREASE IN FUNDS AMOUNT OF \$84,000.00 FOR AN AMENDMED TOTAL AWARD AMOUNT OF \$60,000.00 WITH NO MATCH FOR THE CITY OF LAREDO PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT, FOR THE TERM PERDIOD FROM SEPTEMBER 01, 2025 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2026. FUNDING IS ACCOUNTED FOR IN THE LAREDO PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT FUND – OBESITY PREVENTION GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, The Texas Department of State Health Services contracts with the City of Laredo to provide public health services to residents of Laredo. Through this partnership, the Public Health Department will provide evidence-based education and training for providers, patients, and the community to ensure consistent messaging of reliable health information and collaboration and encourage healthy lifestyles for individuals, families, and communities through health promotion, outreach, and marketing;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept and enter into a contract amendment from the Department of State Health Services (DSHS) for the Obesity Prevention Grant Program for a decrease in funds amount of \$84,000.00 for an amended total award amount of \$60,000.00 with no match for the City of Laredo Public Health Department, for the term period from September 01, 2025 through August 31, 2026. Funding is accounted for in the Laredo Public Health Department Fund – Obesity Prevention Grant Program.

Section 2: The revenue account 226-0000-323-4001 with expenditure division 226-6037 and project number HEOB08.
