

RESOLUTION 2026-RT-18

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO DONATE TWO (2) 2011 GILLIG 40 FT. DIESEL BUSES FROM THE CITY OF LAREDO – LAREDO TRANSIT MANAGEMENT INC. (LTMI) TO SOUTHWEST AREA REGIONAL TRANSIT DISTRICT (SWART) IN EAGLE PASS, TX. THE DONATION WILL BE “AS IS,” AND THE CITY OF LAREDO SHALL ASSUME NO LIABILITY FOR ITS USE FOLLOWING DONATION/TRANSFER. BOTH BUSES HAVE BEEN FULLY DEPRECIATED AND HOLD NO MONETARY VALUE.

WHEREAS, SWART has expressed an urgency for a need of additional rolling stock to meet their community’s transportation demands. These buses will provide reliable transportation to residents who depend on public transportation for medical appointments, employment, school, and daily activities; and

WHEREAS, the vehicles being donated are as described below. These buses were purchased through the Federal Transit Administration grant number ARRA TX-96-X001-01.

- 2011 Gillig diesel bus – VIN #15GGD2716B1178160 Unit #1134; Mileage 647,552; ULB has been met: Vehicle age 15 years.

Date removed from revenue service: Sept. 3, 2025.
- 2011 Gillig diesel bus – VIN #15GGD2718B1178161 Unit #1135; Mileage 583,027; ULB has been met: Vehicle age 15 years.
Date placed in revenue service: 05/12/2011;
Date removed from revenue service: Sept. 8, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND THE MAYOR OF CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1. Authorizing the City Manager to submit all the necessary paperwork to donate the vehicles to SWART and to remove from the City of Laredo - LTMI Asset Inventory; and

Section 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon receiving the official approval from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA).
