PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION: City Council approved the grant award with Resolution #2026-R-74 on March 16, 2026.		
BACKGROUND: The U.S. Border Patrol, Laredo Sector, and the Laredo Police Department (LPD) will combine efforts to bolster Homeland Security-related efforts in the Laredo Sector Area of Responsibility (AOR). Historically LPD has diligently coordinated efforts with the Office of Border Patrol Laredo Sector to safeguard the country's borders through the Treasury Executive Office of Asset Forfeiture (TEOAF). Therefore, this funding will be used to supplement the resources LPD has for officers to safeguard the country's borders.		
FINANCIAL IMPACT: Funding is available in the Special Police Fund.

Whereas, the U.S. Customs and Border Protection/U.S. Border Patrol awarded an additional \$15,000.00 for overtime worked by Laredo Police officer in joint operational task forces for homeland security; and

Whereas, the Chief of Police recommends that City Council authorize the approval of this supplemental overtime grant; and

Whereas, the City Council finds that acceptance of the grant should be made and will be beneficial to the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: Authorizing the City Manager to accept an additional \$15,000.00 from the U.S. Customs and Border Protection/U.S. Border Patrol Treasury Forfeiture Fund for joint operations overtime expenses. The City of Laredo required match will be \$4,800.00 from General Fund, for a total amount of \$19,800.00. Funding is available in the Special Police Fund.
