

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-O-34

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AMEND THE FY 2025–2026 NOISE ABATEMENT FUND BUDGET BY DRAWING DOWN FUND BALANCE AND APPROPRIATING EXPENDITURES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$61,162.89, REPRESENTING FUNDS AWARDED BY THE TEXAS MUNICIPAL LEAGUE (TML) RELATED TO A RESIDENTIAL FIRE. FUNDS WERE RECEIVED IN FY2025 AND DEPOSITED INTO THE OPERATING REVENUE ACCOUNT AND WILL BE UTILIZED FOR THE NOISE ABATEMENT BUILDING IMPROVEMENTS IN FY2026.

WHEREAS, a residential property participating in the City of Laredo’s Noise Abatement Program sustained fire damage; and

WHEREAS, the City received reimbursement funds from the Texas Municipal League (TML) related to the fire claim; and

WHEREAS, said reimbursement was received in FY2025 and deposited into the operating revenue account; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the FY 2025–2026 Noise Abatement Fund budget in order to properly budget and expend these funds for the Noise Abatement Building Improvements expenses;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1:

The FY 2025–2026 Noise Abatement Fund budget is hereby amended by drawing down fund balance and appropriating expenditures in the amount of \$61,162.89, representing funds awarded by the Texas Municipal League (TML), for expenses in the Noise Abatement Building Improvements account.

Section 2:

The City Manager is hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to implement this budget amendment.

Section 3:

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be cumulative of all other ordinances or parts of ordinances governing or regulating the same subject matter; provided, however, that all prior ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4:

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more portions may be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 5:

This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
