Rock Solid is currently constructing a 6 ft wide multi-use path in Texas' newest State Park, offering an outdoor recreation experience for the nearby DFW area.

This beginner friendly trail was constructed near San Diego, CA in the spring of 2023.

The "Shred To School" trail in Madison, WI offers distinctly unique experiences by combining a traditional greenway and a winding, bike optimized chip seal option.
