

RESOLUTION # 2026-R-74

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT AND ACCEPT REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION/U.S. BORDER PATROL TREASURY FORFEITURE FUND OF UP TO \$265,000.00 FOR JOINT OPERATIONS FOR OVERTIME EXPENSES. THE CITY OF LAREDO REQUIRED MATCH WILL BE \$84,800.00, FROM GENERAL FUND, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$349,800.00. FUNDING IS AVAILABLE IN THE SPECIAL POLICE FUND.

Whereas, the Joint Operations overtime agreement between the City of Laredo Police Department and U.S. Customs and Border Protection/U.S. Border Patrol is in the amount of up to \$349,800.00 for overtime and fringe benefits worked by Laredo Police officers in joint operational task forces for homeland security; and

Whereas, the Chief of Police recommends that the City Council authorize the approval of this supplemental overtime grant; and

Whereas, the City Council finds that acceptance of the grant should be made and will be beneficial to the city; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: Authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement and accept reimbursement from the U.S. Customs and Border Protection/U.S. Border Patrol Treasury Forfeiture Fund of up to \$265,000.00 for joint operations for overtime expenses. The City of Laredo required match will be \$84,800.00, from General Fund, for a total amount of \$349,800.00. Funding is available in the Special Police Fund.

Section 2: Funding is available in the Special Police Fund.
