

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FROM THE TEXAS HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMISSION (HHSC) FOR THE ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AND RELATED DEMENTIAS (ARD) GRANT IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$150,000.00, WITH NO MATCH FOR THE CITY OF LAREDO PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT FOR THE TERM PERIOD FROM SEPTEMBER 01, 2026 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2027. FUNDS WILL BE ACCOUNTED FOR IN THE LAREDO PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT FUND – ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AND RELATED DEMENTIAS (ARD) GRANT.

WHEREAS, The Texas Health and Human Services Commission contracts with the City of Laredo Public Health Department for the Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementias (ARD) Grant. Through this program, Laredo Public Health will be able to provide education, support, and referrals to community resources to persons with ARD and their caregivers and promote early detection and diagnosis through priorities and strategies found in the Healthy Brain Initiative, State and Local Public Health Partnerships to Address Dementia: The 2023-2027 Road Map.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept and enter into a contract from the Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) for the Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementias (ARD) Grant Program for an award amount of \$150,000, with no match for The City of Laredo Public Health Department for the period from September 01, 2026 through August 31, 2027. Funds will be accounted for in the Laredo Public Health Department Fund – Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementias (ARD) Grant.

Section 2: The revenue account 226-0000-323-4011 and the expenditure division is 226-6052 with Project Numbers HEAD03.
