

RESOLUTION 2026-R-34

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$40,000.00 TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION FOR THE FY2027 FIRST RESPONDER MENTAL HEALTH GRANT, PEER SUPPORT PROGRAM. THE GRANT PERFORMANCE PERIOD WILL BE OCTOBER 01, 2026 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2027. THE LAREDO POLICE DEPARTMENT WILL UTILIZE THIS FUNDING TO OBTAIN A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACT FOR CLINICAL ADVISORY FOR TRAUMA AND WORK-RELATED COUNSELING, TRAINING, AND OUTREACH SUPPLIES FOR THE SUSTAINMENT OF THE LPD PEER SUPPORT PROGRAM. THE 20% REQUIRED MATCH FOR THE CITY OF LAREDO IS APPROXIMATELY \$8,000.00 FROM GENERAL FUND. FUNDING WILL BE AVAILABLE IN THE SPECIAL POLICE FUND.

Whereas, the City of Laredo finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Laredo, that the Peer Support Program be operated for the 2026-2027 fiscal year; and

Whereas, the Police Chief recommends that City Council authorize this grant application to obtain a professional service contact for peer support; and

Whereas, the City of Laredo agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Peace Officer Mental Health Program grant application; and

Whereas, the City of Laredo agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City of Laredo assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full.

Whereas, the City of Laredo designates the City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate this grant on behalf of the City of Laredo; and

Whereas, the City of Laredo designates the Financial Services Administrator as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1 Authorizing the City Manager to submit a grant application in the estimated amount of \$27,803.85 to the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division for the FY2027 First Responder Mental Health Grant, Peer Support Program. The grant performance period will be October 01, 2026 through September 30, 2027. The Laredo Police Department will utilize this funding to obtain a professional service contract for Clinical Advisory for Trauma and Work-Related Counseling, training, and outreach supplies for the sustainment of the LPD Peer Support Program. The 20% required match for the City of Laredo is approximately \$5,560.77 from General Fund. Grant funding will be available in the Special Police Fund.

Section 2: It authorizes the City Manager to execute all necessary forms and documents to obtain said grant and to effectuate its terms.
