A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO RATIFY, ACCEPT AND ENTER INTO A CONTINUATION CONTRACT FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF STATE HEALTH SERVICES OFFICE OF BORDER PUBLIC HEALTH (OBPH) FOR THE HEALTHY BORDER GRANT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,999.00 WITH NO MATCH FOR THE CITY OF LAREDO PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT FOR THE TERM PERIOD FROM SEPTEMBER 01, 2025 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2026. FUNDS WILL BE ALLOCATED IN THE LAREDO PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT FUND – OBPH HEALTHY BORDER GRANT.

WHEREAS, The Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) Office of Public Health (OBPH) has contracted with the City of Laredo Public Health Department to provide promotion of unity and friendship between the public health officials of neighboring cities and regions, examining health needs, share epidemiological data, assess current and emerging public health concerns, and share available programs with particular attention and concern to the council's geographical area, and to consider joint actions in common benefit of population of both sides of the border.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept and enter into a continuation contract from the Texas Department of State Health Services Office of Border Public Health (OBPH) Healthy Border Grant, in the amount of \$9,999.00 with no match for the City of Laredo Public Health Department for the term period from September 01, 2025 through August 31, 2025. Funds will be allocated in the Laredo Public Health Department Fund – OBPH Healthy Border Grant.

Section 2: The revenue account 226-0000-323-4004 and the expenditure division is 226-6012 with Project Number HEHB25.
