

International Bridge Ceremony Timeline

- **0500 - 0530 hours**

- Bridge Closure:

Mexican Customs will be notified to stop traffic flow

ATCET Officers will stop traffic outbound

CBP Officers will process all vehicles on the bridge until the last vehicle is inspected and admitted.

**Press release sent to media/city/ stakeholders to advise of bridge closure. Colombia Solidarity Bridge will open at 0600 hours to aid with traffic.*

- **0530 - 0620 hours**

- WBCA personnel and the U.S. Army will begin the construction of the stage and press area at mid-bridge.

- CBP officers will post at security checkpoint to verify proper entry credentials for guests (Official Pass/ Media Pass/Security pin).

- 0620 hours: Stage and press area is expected to be complete and ready for the event.

- **0620 - 0630 hours**

- VIP vehicles, selected law enforcement vehicles and bus convoys will arrive at the bridge and will be directed to designated staging area.

**LEOs advised to arrive at 0600 hours and will be staged at approximately 0620 hours*

- **0630 - 0715 hours**

- Abrazo participants and media personnel will arrive at the bridge and be directed to mid-bridge for event staging.

- **0715 - 0730 hours**

- Abrazo honored guests will prepare to exit breakfast at La Posada Hotel. Once lined up outside the venue, they will proceed to the bridge ceremony.

- **0730- 0845 hours**

- WBCA International Bridge Ceremony commences.

- **0845 - 0900 hours**

- Ceremony ending:

VIP guests will exit via lane 1 where designated convoys will be on standby.

Abrazo Participants will exit via lanes 13,14 and 15 to make proper entry and proceed to bus staging area for departure. (Lanes manned by PAX)

- WBCA personnel and the U.S. Army will remove the staging area from mid-bridge.

-Traffic resumes at the Juarez-Lincoln International Bridge at approximately 0900 hrs.
