

## **ORDINANCE NO. 2024-O-273**

### **REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 2000-O-295 AND SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS REPEALING ORDINANCES 2000-O-295, 2010-O-139 AND 2023-O-027 OF THE CITY OF LAREDO CODE OF ORDINANCES. ORDINANCE 2000-O-295 ESTABLISHED THE SPEED HUMP INSTALATION POLICY FOR THE CITY OF LAREDO AND FURTHER PROVIDED PROCEDURES AND PRIORITIES FOR SPEED HUMP INSTALLATION, REMOVAL, ALTERATION, LOCATION, ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND COST SHARING CRITERIA; ORDINANCES 2010-O-139 AND 2023-O-027 AMENDED ORDINANCE 2000-O-295; PROVIDING FOR THE FOLLOWING FINDINGS OF FACT: REPEAL OF ORDINANCES 2000-O-295, 2010-O-139 AND 2023-O-027; REPEALER, SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE, AND FINDING PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Laredo is a Home Rule City acting under its Charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Laredo finds that on **November 27, 2000** the City Council adopted Ordinance 2000-O-295 which established the speed hump installation policy for the City of Laredo and further provided procedures and priorities for speed hump installation, removal, alteration, location, eligibility requirements, and cost sharing criteria; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Laredo finds that on **September 20, 2010** the City Council adopted Ordinance 2010-O-139 which amended Ordinance 2000-O-295 and modified language in the policy to reflect the use of speed cushions instead of speed humps, added minimum requirements to the special provision for the installation of speed cushions, and to incorporate other changes to the established installation procedures; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Laredo finds that on **February 6, 2023** the City Council adopted Ordinance 2023-O-027 which amended Ordinance 2000-O-295 and modified language in the policy to reflect the use of speed humps instead of speed cushions, removed minimum requirements of one official accident report from the special provision for the installation of asphalt speed humps, reduced the amount of signatures for the petition requirements, and to incorporate other changes to the established installation procedures; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Laredo wishes to repeal Ordinance 2000-O-295, 2010-O-139 and 2023-O-027.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO, TEXAS THAT:**

#### **Section 1. FINDINGS OF FACT**

The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance by reference of fact as if expressly set forth herein.

**Section 2.** REPEAL OF ORDINANCE 2000-O-295, 2010-O-139 and 2023-O-027.

City of Laredo Ordinance 2000-O-295, 2010-O-139 and 2023-O-027 are hereby repealed in their entirety.

**Section 3.** REPEALER

All ordinances, resolutions, or parts thereof, that are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and remain controlling as to the matters regulated, herein.

**Section 4.** SEVERABILITY

Should any of the clauses, sentences, paragraphs, sections or parts of this Ordinance be deemed invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable by a court of law or administrative agency with jurisdiction over the matter, such action shall not be construed to affect any other valid portion of this Ordinance.

**Section 5.** CODIFICATION

The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to record and publish the language of this repealing Ordinance, and any changes thereto, in the City's Code of Ordinances.

**Section 6.** EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication.

**Section 7.** PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was attended by a quorum of the City Council, was open to the public, and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.
